## Lite Scratch Tour Florida-Pensacola CC - Notice to Players - March 12-13, 2016

USGA Rules of Golf Apply

- 1. Open Division: Miller Lite Blue tee markers.
  - Senior Division: Miller Lite White tee markers.
  - Super Senior Division Miller Lite Gold tee markers.
- 2. The maximum score for any hole is triple bogey.
- 3. Embedded ball rule is in effect through the green except for sandy areas (waste areas, bunkers).
- 4. The newly renovated area left of hole number 9 is considered a waste area (no relief).
- 5. Distance measuring devices are allowed.
- 6. Free relief is allowed if your ball rests in any newly sodded areas.
- 7. The areas where trees were recently removed (right of number 1 green, front left and back right of number 3 green, right of number 15 fairway adjacent to the creek are considered ground round under repair. Other ground under repair is defined by white painted areas.
- 8. If there is any doubt as to procedure, play 2 balls as prescribed under rule 3-3
- 9. Each round consist of two (2) nine (9) hole stipulated rounds
- 10. Free relief is allowed from artificially paved surfaces ONLY. Crushed stone walking paths through waste areas are an integral part of the course (no relief).
- 11. Stones, rocks and shells may be removed from bunkers.
- 12. As an additional option under rule 26, a drop area is provided for balls lying in the lateral hazard on hole number 11.
- 13. Immovable obstructions within two club lengths of the putting green: If a ball lies through the green and an immovable obstruction (sprinkler head, etc) within two club lengths of the putting green AND within two club lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief.
- 14. Free relief may be taken from bunker liners, but the ball must be dropped in the bunker no nearer the hole.
- 15. Out of bounds is defined by roads, fences, stakes and lines.
- 16. Please return your scorecard to the scoring area IMMEDIATELY upon completion of play.

Any player that does not return a score for round 1 will be placed into the lowest flight within his division for flighting purposes.

Ties for overall first place in open and senior divisions will be broken by sudden death playoff
All other ties (including ties determining division placement) will be broken by scorecard playoff in the following
manner: low score on back nine, low score on holes 13-18, low score 16-18, hole by hole match of scorecard working
backward starting at number 18. Ties for division breakout after Saturday's round will result with the winner of the
playoff moving to the lower division.
