

Lite Scratch Tour Florida—Santa Rosa Notice to Players – June 24-25, 2017

USGA Rules of Golf Apply

TEE MARKERS: Miller Lite Tee Markers - Open: Blue, Senior: White, Super Senior: Gold

MAXIMUM SCORE: The maximum score on any hole is **TRIPLE BOGEY**.

RANGE FINDERS: Are allowed.

CART PATHS: Relief is allowed from paved surfaces only.

HAZARDS: Hazards are marked with stakes and/or lines. The waterside edge of the bulkheads on #8, #11, and #12 are considered as the boundary of the hazard and will be played as immovable obstructions if your ball lies outside of the hazard. The only drop area provided on hole number 6 for balls that enter the hazard behind the waste area on the right. Drop areas NOT marked with Miller Lite signs are NOT to be used.

OUT OF BOUNDS is defined by white stakes and lines and public roadways.

Questions as to procedure: If there is any doubt as to procedure, play 2 balls as prescribed under rule 3-3

Beds around number 18 green: If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball lies in the bedded area surrounding #18 green, you may take relief without penalty. Establish the point of entry and drop the ball within one club length from the nearest

EMBEDDED BALL: The embedded ball rule is in effect through the green.

STIPULATED ROUNDS: Each 18 hole round will consist of two (2) nine (9) hole stipulated rounds.

SUSPENSION OF PLAY: IF YOU FEEL THREATENED BY LIGHTNING AT ANY TIME, LEAVE THE COURSE IMMEDIATELY. DO NOT WAIT FOR OFFICIAL NOTIFICATION. The tour staff will try to notify all players when play is suspended.

Divisions: Open – Johnson (season), Moore (this event) automatically in A flight. Fierro (this event) B flight or higher, Kendall Griner (this event) C flight or higher. **Senior** - Black (season), Szudarski (this event), automatically in A flight; Jay Manuel (this event) B flight or higher. **Super Senior** - Peel (season), Napier (season), Daniell (season), Gross (this event), Hinkle (this event) Automatically in A flight

All division flights will be split based on first round score. Ties for split will be broken by (in order): best back nine score, best score on holes 13-18, best score on holes 16-18, hole by hole working backwards starting on hole 18, winner moving to lower division. Ties for 1st place overall in each division will be broken by sudden death playoff. All other ties broken in same manner as division splits.

The only drop area provided on hole number 6 for balls that enter the hazard behind the waste area on the right. Drop areas NOT marked with Miller Lite signs are NOT to be used.

Beds around number 18 green: If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball lies in the bedded area surrounding #18 green, you may take relief without penalty. Establish the point of entry and drop the ball within one club length from the nearest

All division flights will be split based on first round score.
