USGA Rules Apply (play the ball down)

- 1. Open Division will play from the Miller Lite blue tee markers. Senior Division will play from the Miller Lite white tee markers. Super Senior Division will play from the Miller Lite gold tee markers.
- 2. The maximum score for any hole is triple bogey.
- 3. Embedded ball rule is in effect through the green.
- 4. Distance measuring devices are allowed.
- 5. Free relief is allowed if your ball rests in any newly sodded area.
- 6. Free relief (swing and stance only) is allowed from ropes holding up newly planted trees.
- 7. Out of bounds is defined by white stakes and white painted curbs on holes 1,8,9,16,18. Any ball which crosses the road on number 9 or number 16 is considered out of bounds even if it lies on another part of the course. Any tee shot on the 4th hole that comes to rest left of the hole number 2 cart path is considered out of bounds.
- 8. Ground under repair is defined by white painted circles.
- 9. Free relief is granted from ball coming to rest in the driving range. Use the drop area nearest to where your ball lies.
- 10. The penalty area on numbers 3 and 5 are yellow penalty areas. A drop area is provided as an additional option under rule 22-1 for ball entering the yellow penalty areas on numbers 3 and 5.
- 11. The concrete retaining walls on numbers 10 and 12 are considered part of the hazard.
- 12. If there is any doubt as to procedure, play 2 balls as prescribed under rule 3-3
- 13. Each round consist of two (2) nine (9) hole stipulated rounds
- 14. Free relief is allowed from artificially paved surfaces ONLY.
- 15. Stones, rocks and shells may be removed from bunkers.
- 16. If the Dothan CC lightning alarm sounds, immediately discontinue play find a place of safety.
- 17. Please return your scorecard to the scoring area IMMEDIATELY upon completion of play.

Ties for first place in A divisions will be broken by sudden death playoff
